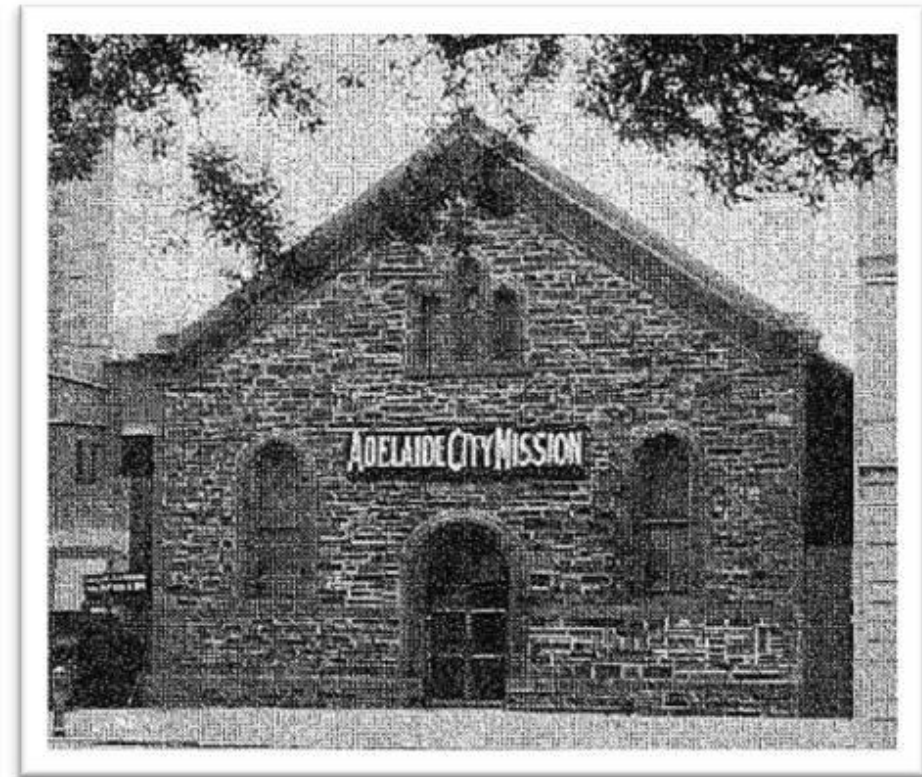

Mission Australia alcohol and other drug treatment – service footprint

South Australia

AOD Outreach (Adelaide Metro)

(Adelaide Primary Health Network funded)

- Delivery of service for 16 years
- Outreach program – case management, assessment counselling intervention and advocacy
- Young people aged 12-24 years

Triple Care Farm (NSW Southern Highlands)

Flagship service delivery of 30 years

18 bed, 12 week resi-rehab including youth detox facility and AOD program for young people with co-morbid substance dependence and mental illness.

Junaa Buwa! And Mac River (Dubbo, NSW)

Residential rehab centre for young people (connected with juvenile justice system) who have a history of alcohol and other drug use

DAYS - Drug and Alcohol Youth Service (Perth)

Multi-disciplinary team that specialises in substance use treatment for 12-23 year olds in both community and residential settings.

Stringy Bark Residential Rehab Service (Darwin)

A client-centred program developed provide residential, day and therapeutic programs for clients with alcohol and other drug addictions.

Eligibility

Young people 10-24 years with AOD concerns
Parents/caregivers with AOD concerns (whose children have no concerns) or a combination of both

Priority Groups (per the National Drug Strategy)

Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people
Culturally and linguistically diverse (CALD)
Gender and sexually diverse (LGBTIQ+) people

Service Model – Outreach (community based)

Working with up to 90 clients at any one time

Psychosocial Treatment types *

- **Counselling** e.g. CBT, Narrative Therapy, Dialectic Behaviour Therapy
- **Case Management**
- **Supports for significant others** (eg family)
- **Early Intervention**
- **Information and Education**

Episodes of care

- Bio-psychosocial assessment
- 16 sessions over 3 months with re-referral and re-entry as required on exit

Evaluation Framework

- Impact measurement (personal wellbeing index) integrated with Australian Treatment Outcomes Profile (ATOP)
