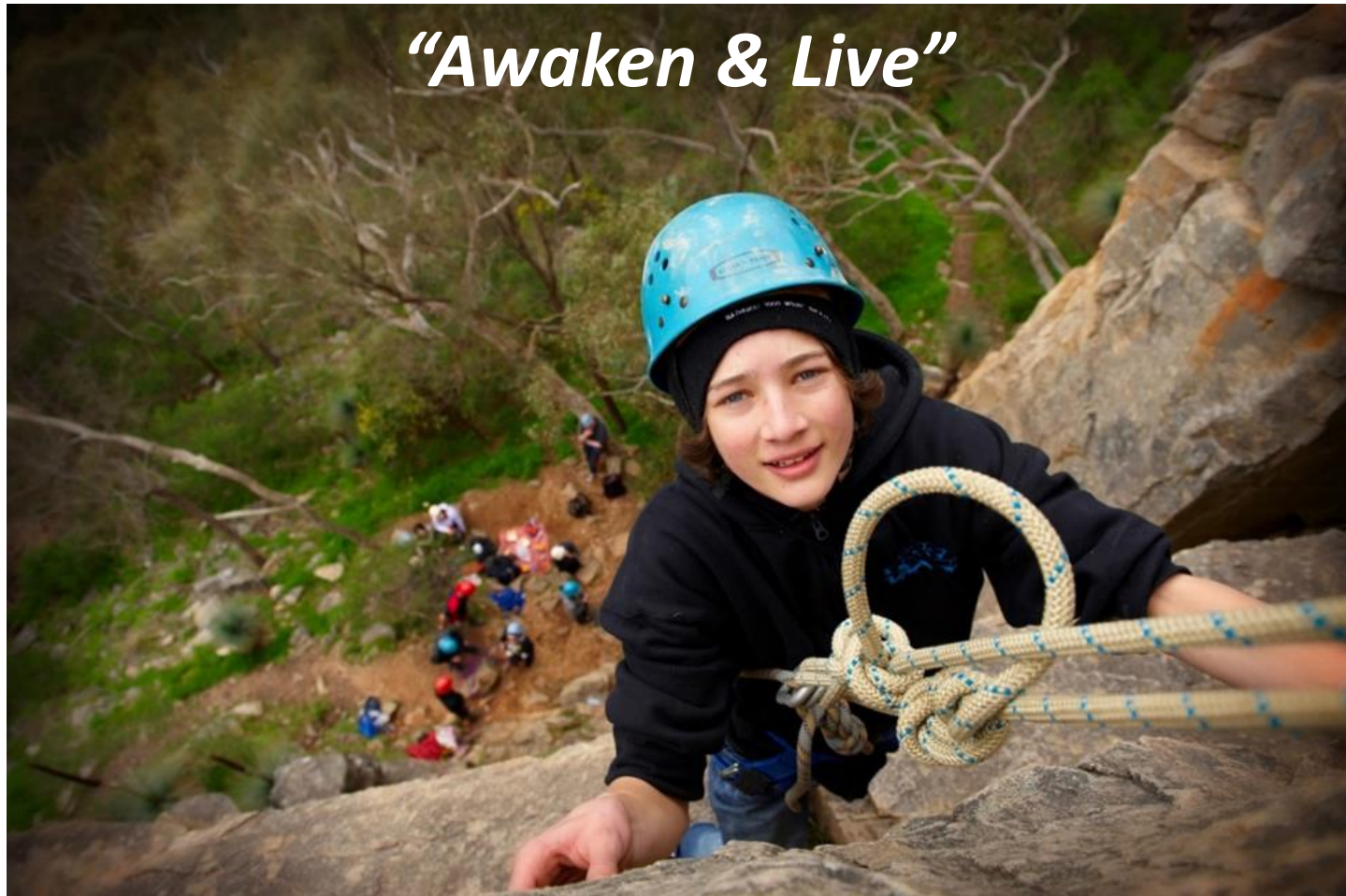

their Circle of Support
(e.g. family members, significant others)*
- 48 Young People in total
- Rural Hills/Fleurieu location

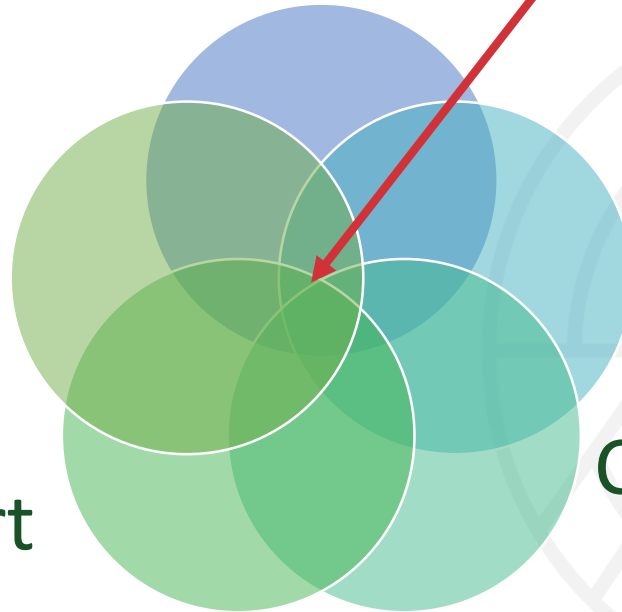

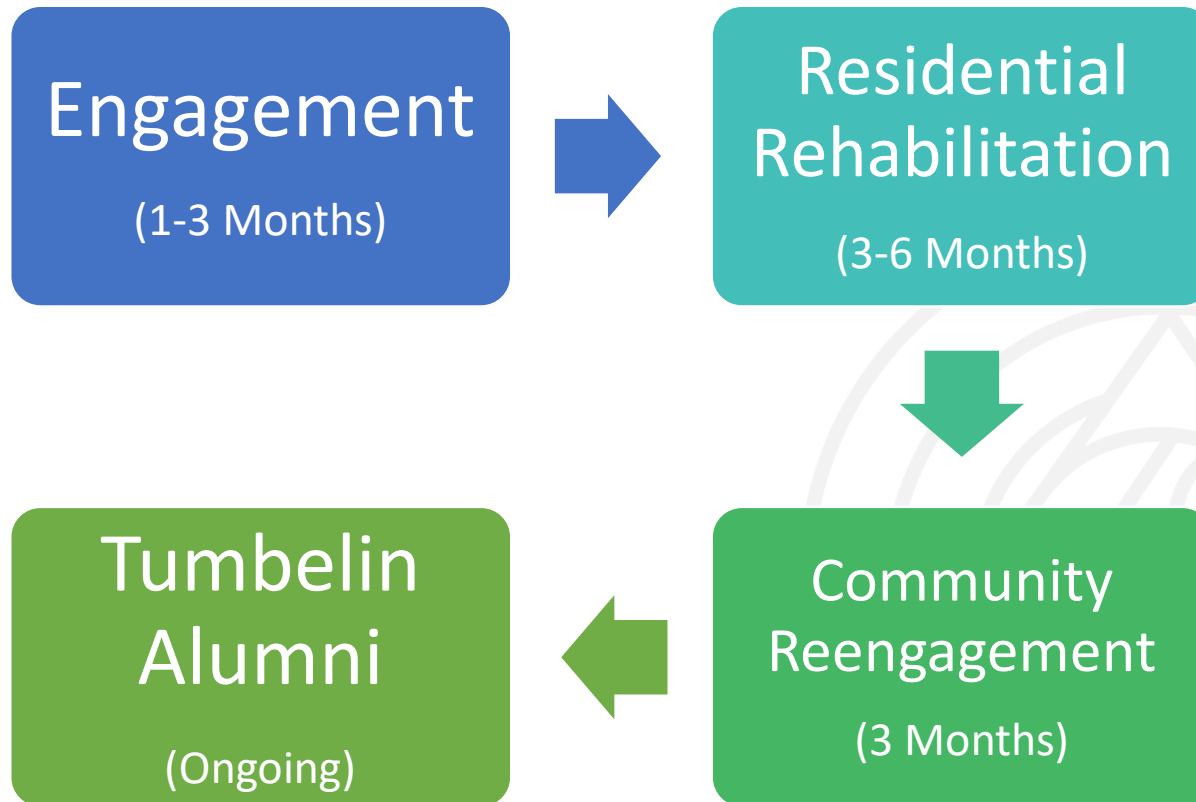

- Aug 19 - Staff Team appointments and training
